

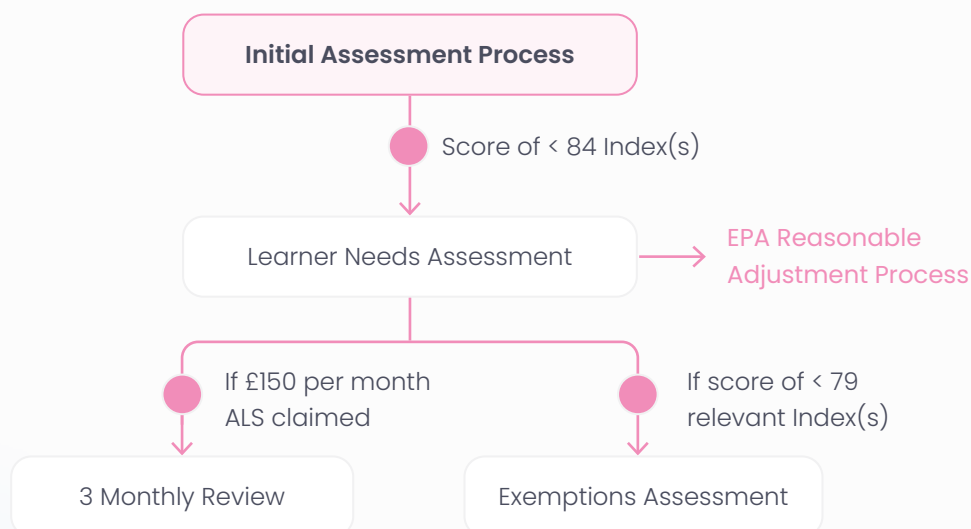

What is Robust?

Included in key guidance, published in conjunction with JCQ

The assessment must be recognised by level 7 assessors and consultants in the sector.

- ✓ The Cognassist Cognitive Assessment is independently verified and included in key guidance published in conjunction with JCQ and Patoss, accepted by Ofqual regulated Awarding organisations and End Point Assessment Organisations.

Evidence-based psychometric assessment

Only clinically robust evidence based psychometric assessments can be used to evidence eligibilities at exams or assessments. This evidence should be published in a technical manual.

- ✓ The Cognassist Cognitive Assessment is a psychometric assessment and we have published a technical manual reviewed and accepted by independent authorities.

Performance-based assessment not self-reported assessment

These involve testing of cognitive function through performance of specifically designed tasks and remove potential conscious or unconscious biases of the user.

- ✓ The Cognassist Cognitive Assessment is performance based.

Performance Validity Tests

If the assessment tasks are not delivered by an assessor, the assessment should include performance validity tests.

- ✓ The Cognassist Cognitive Assessment includes 9 performance validity tests.

Assessment delivered through suitable technology

The assessment must be delivered suitably, this includes browser based, tablet-based or paper-based delivery. This does not include mobile based assessments.
